Fairview's Chevre Roue, a robust goat's milk cheese was awarded a gold rating. Its Botham's Cremezola Blue, a creamy, gorgonzola-style cheese, won a silver rating while the Saint Louis, a white mould cheese made from Jersey milk, received a bronze rating.
