

DHL Global Forwarding strengthens Central, Southern Africa leadership teams

DHL Global Forwarding has made some major changes to its leadership teams in Central and Southern Africa to strengthen its market position.

For Central Africa, Veronique Ebenye Epangue will lead the DHL team in Cameroon, while Alassane Mare, CEO for DHL Global Forwarding Central Africa will take on the additional responsibility as country manager for Gabon. Epangue joined DPDHL Group over 20 years ago as a trainee at DHL Express and she was appointed DHL Global Forwarding sales executive in 2009 and head of sales and customer service in 2016.
